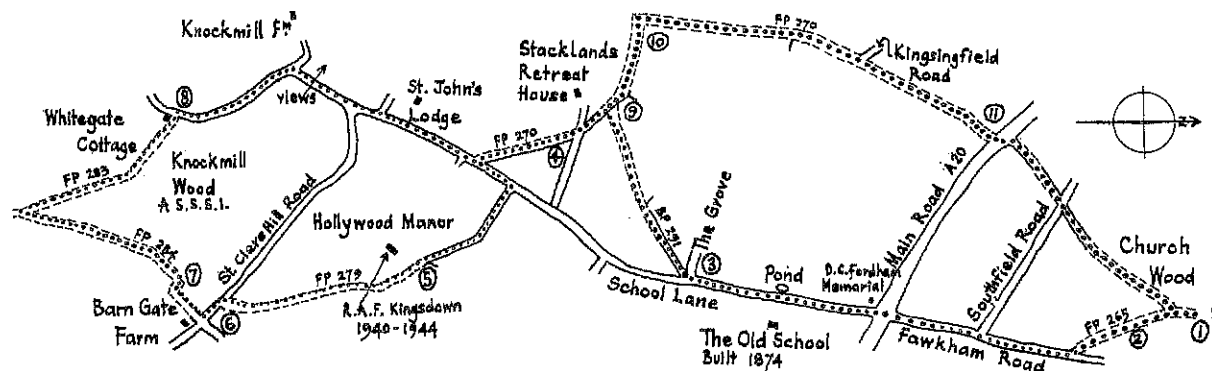


Walk N° 2.

4 miles taking 2 hours, over level ground.



1. The walk starts in the Church Wood car park.
 2. Standing with one's back to the lychgate, walk forward along FP265, ignoring a path which leads off diagonally to right. Upon reaching Fawkham Road turn right and walk to the A20, cross over into School Lane.
 3. At The Grove, follow bridlepath 291 through Stacklands Wood until a cross path adjacent to an old direction post is reached; turn left on to FP270 towards and over Stacklands Retreat drive to a stile into open field.
 4. Follow the hedgerow on your left to a stile into School Lane opposite Hollywood Manor; turn left, quickly coming upon path 279 on right, up three steps and along enclosed path with a close-boarded fence on left.
 5. The path becomes a farm track, which is followed up to a metal field gate with a stile. Cross over and continue along track to another gate and stile on to St. Clere Hill Road.
6. Turn left, towards a FP sign at the entrance to Barn Gate Farm, walk along farm entrance track FP284 to gate with stile; continue straight ahead following FP direction arrows, turn sharp right to stile in corner.
 7. Cross stile and walk diagonally left to another stile into an open field with Knockmill Wood on your right; follow stock fence for several hundred yards to stile in right-hand corner, over stile on to a (usually) obvious path through a cultivated field towards Drane Farm; just before reaching a wooden waymark post turn diagonally right on to FP283, over the same field, to a corner of the wood, then walk towards Whitegate Cottage, along a gravel drive, into Tinkerpot Lane.
 8. Turn right and follow the lane back towards the A20 noting the fine views on the bend. After passing St John's Lodge on left a stile is soon reached also on your left, go over stile to the route previously used, FP270; cross field with hedge on your right to stile where you cross Stacklands Retreat drive again.
 9. Continue along an enclosed path and cross over BR291, soon reaching a stile into a field, where on the left hand side is woodland, followed by another stile.
 10. Walk straight ahead before turning right to follow a wooden-fenced paddock, the path is in between a bungalow and stables. This soon becomes a surfaced track leading to the southern end of Kingsingfield Road at which point on path 270 the walker encounters a walk-around barrier. Here the path is enclosed but it soon reaches an open field which is usually cultivated and the path continues straight ahead to the A20.
 11. Cross over the Main Road to a FP276 sign into Meadow Bank Close. Keep to the left-hand pavement to Ash Tree Drive and cross to an enclosed path between a garage and tall conifers. Upon reaching Southfield Road cross directly over as the path continues into Church Wood. Go straight ahead crossing the fire break and quickly finding FP265 entering from your right, turn left for the car park.
