

PARISH COUNCIL OF WEST KINGSDOWN

BYELAWS

Made under Section 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 by  
the Parish Council of West Kingsdown with respect to a

RECREATION GROUND

1. Throughout these byelaws the expression "the Council" means the Parish Council of West Kingsdown and the expression "the ground" means the Gamecock Meadow, Main Road, West Kingsdown, Kent.
2. An act necessary to the proper execution of his duty on the ground by an officer of the Council, or by any person or servant of any person employed by the Council, shall not be deemed an offence against these byelaws.
3. A person shall not in the ground
  - a) climb any wall or fence or gate in or enclosing the ground, or any building, barrier, railing, post or seat or any other erection or ornament;
  - b) throw or discharge any missile to the danger or annoyance of any other person in the ground;
  - c) Affix any bill, placard, or notice to or upon any part of any building, seat or other erection, other than on the approved Notice Board, and in pursuance of a lawful agreement with the Council;
  - d) intentionally obstruct, disturb or annoy any other person in the proper use of the ground, or intentionally obstruct or disturb any officer of the Council in the proper execution of his duty, or any person or servant of any person employed by the Council in the proper execution of his duty.
4. A person shall not in the ground, light any fire or place or throw or let fall a lighted match or any other thing so as to be likely to cause a fire.
5. A person shall not, except with the consent of the Council, erect any post, rail, fence, pole, tent, booth, stand, building or other structure on the ground.
6. A person shall not in the Ground except in the exercise of any lawful right or privilege ride or lead any horse, pony or donkey.
7. (i) A person shall not, except in the exercise of any lawful right or privilege, bring or cause to be brought on to the ground any barrow, truck, machine, motor car, motor cycle or vehicle other than a) a wheeled bicycle or other similar machine;
